History AutoCAD was first developed by Chip Morningstar and his team of programmers at Micro Designs, Inc., a studio in Baltimore, Maryland in 1979. The name was chosen after Morningstar decided that the project should be able to be used to model all kinds of products. Morningstar had worked at the United States Department of Defense and had developed the SAE Project LABS, which was intended to assist the development of personal transportation. In 1979, the US Army approached the computer animation studio and asked Morningstar if he could develop a computer-aided drafting system that would help its personnel manage and distribute all of its plans and designs. When the software was completed, the U.S. Army became the first user of the software in 1981. After Micro Designs and Morningstar decided to commercialize the software, other companies bought the rights to market the software. In December 1982, AutoCAD was released for the IBM PC DOS operating system. In October 1983, Autodesk, Inc. acquired the rights to Autocad and in January 1984, the first version of AutoCAD was released for the MS-DOS operating system. The first AutoCAD version released for the Apple Macintosh was AutoCAD 1988. In March 1991, AutoCAD 2000 was released. In July 1993, AutoCAD LT was released. AutoCAD LT is supported by AutoCAD.
